BELGRADE SIGHTSEEING TOUR

Half day tour / Heritage / Touristic Sites / Belgrade Fortress

A perfect panoramic tour of the most important monuments which marked the history of our capital city, St. Sava Temple, Slavia Square, Palace of Serbia, New and Old Palace, National Theatre, and National Museum.

The highlight is the walking tour which we start from the fortress. Belgrade Fortress represents an open-air museum that had been changing and developing over time. There are located numerous monuments, such as The Clock Tower, Roman well, Kula Nebojsa/ Daredevil Tower, as well as the oldest park in Belgrade-Kalemegdan Park, with many sports terrains and courts, playgrounds, and a zoo.

After the Belgrade fortress, we will walk along the famous Knez Mihailova Street, where we will see many 19th-century architectural monuments: the National Bank building, and the old Question Mark? Cafe, Princess Ljubica's residence. We will finish our tour at Beton Hall, where we will have a break for lunch.

Free time for shopping or back to the hotel for overnight and sleep.

Suggestion: Dinner at Skadarlija Street with live music.

NOVI SAD AND SREMSKI KARLOVCI

Whole day tour / Novi Sad / Petrovaradin Fortress / Sremski Karlovci

Departure after breakfast at 10:00 by bus.

A brief panoramic tour of Novi Sad, the capital of the Vojvodina region. Vibrant walking through the city center and along picturesque Dunavska Street.

We will visit the famous Petrovaradin fortress, built in the 17th and 18th centuries and once called Gibraltar on the Danube. This Austrian artillery fortification situated above the river represents the second-largest structure of its kind preserved in Europe. In the upper town, there are the bastions: Lower Ludwig's Bastion, Upper Ludwig's Bastion, Innocentie's, Maria Theresa's, St. Leopold's, and Tsar Joseph's. Access is possible via gates Ludwig, Leopold, Molinary, Karlo VI, and Court Gate.

Free time for a lunch break at one of the restaurants at the fortress.

After lunch short drive to the romantic town of Sremski Karlovci which was once a hub of the cultural and political life of the Serbs. You will enjoy a panoramic guided walk of this lovely town with the Baroque Four Lions fountain on the main square (1790), a 19th-century High school, the Patriarch Palace, and the mid-18th century Cathedral with a fine Renaissance facade and two Baroque belfries.

In the heart of Sremski Karlovci with a view of the beautiful Gymnasium, there is a small family winery "Došen" which is an inevitable part of the tour. Their tasting room consists of spaces located in the house, on the porch, and in the garden, decorated like the guest rooms of civil society from the 19th century. The shelves and walls tempt you to get up and take a closer look at the legacy of many generations. Then the wine arrives and talks start about the vines, the first the ones planted in the yard - Straveski, then Viktoria, Black Magic, Prima, Slanamenka, Muscat Hamburg, Merlot, Cabernet, and Chardonnay.


Return to Belgrade around 19:00. Free time according to the group's wish. We can go to Sava Promenade there are many outdoor restaurants.

TREASURE OF THE ZLATIBOR MOUNTAIN

Whole day / Zlatibor Experience/ Lake / Gondola Panoramic Ride

Start point Belgrade.

Check-out and departure after breakfast at 9:00 by bus.

Transfer to western Serbia and Zlatibor Mountain, one of the most beautiful in Serbia.

Zlatibor is an area of unique ecological, biological, cultural, and aesthetic value, preserved and picturesque landscapes, meadows, pastures, and centuries-old pine forests, with valuable objects of folk architecture, cultural and historical heritage, and is recognizable for its health, tourism, and recreational facilities.

Arrival at the hotel, check-in, and lunch (if requested).

Free time to enjoy the spa center at the hotel or a refreshing walk down the lake, and a gondola (cable car) panoramic ride will provide an impressive 25 minutes with an incredible view of the picturesque landscapes of Zlatibor. Nine kilometers of the most modern air route of the Zlatibor gondola connects the center of Zlatibor with the ski center Tornik, across Ribnica Lake, where the intermediate station is located.

Dinner at the hotel, overnight.

Note: On this day we can use to visit Sirogojno village (the tour below) and the group can have lunch in the Ethno tavern in the village.

MOKRA GORA & SHARGAN EIGHT RAILWAY

Nostalgic tour/ Mokra Gora / Shargan 8/ Drvengrad

Mokra Gora is a picturesque mountain village that stretches between the mountains of Tara and Zlatibor. A great attraction is an ethnic settlement Drvengrad (e.g. wooden/log houses), on the hill Mećavnik, built according to the idea of our famous film director Emir Kusturica. You will enjoy the unique atmosphere and nature, eat for lunch/or dinner locally homemade food at one of Kusturica's restaurants, and buy handmade souvenirs.

Mećavnik is already enough of an attraction in itself thanks to its name, its visual identity, its architecture, and the people who built it, using skills and knowledge of traditional building methods that time long forgotten. And thanks, too, to its staff, who, for the most part, have never been trained in the hospitality industry, but who, after ten years of working here with guests, would be welcome members of any hotel team.

Nostalgic tour - Šargan Eight a popular attraction here is the old narrow-gauge railway, Shargan Eight, which goes 300 meters uphill and forms a perfect number 8. We'll take a 2,5 hours ride at 10:30 by train Ćira. In the distant past, Mokra Gora and Shargan were on a significant road route, as evidenced by the remains of an old Roman cobbled road and tombs from the Roman period. Along the railway, there are a number of exhibits, old locomotives, and wagons, which are protected as monuments of technical culture, which makes this area a unique open-air museum.

The wagons are authentic, and made of wooden benches. Passing through the tunnels, in complete darkness, is a real adventure that remains in the memory forever. The train makes frequent breaks at the most beautiful viewpoints with an interesting story from the guide.

SIROGOJNO VILLAGE

Sirogojno Village / Stopica Cave/ Village lunch

Visit Old Village - Sirogojno (Sirogoyno) which is placed under state protection. An open-air Museum representing the authentic village dating from the late 19th and early 20th centuries. It shows the life of a rural family and the old national architecture preserved in the region of Zlatibor Mountain.

We will also visit the unique Knitters Museum where you'll see products such as unique in the world Sirogojno sweaters, jackets, caps, scarves, and socks exhibited in the museum. The story of how women have processed wool from flees to hemp and spool by themselves, spun, wove, and knitted blankets and clothes for their family, and their trade is as old as the world. Apartment lodgings in cottages and a souvenir shop with a tavern will be an unforgettable impression.

Here you can learn everything about old crafts and how people lived in the countryside of Zlatibor mountain, how they ate, made milk, dried meat, fruit, herbal teas, keep wine, made rakia...

Lunch in a traditional house - restaurant "Krčma". This original ambiance and especially the traditional Serbian food made in a way that is over 100 years old and typical for Zlatibor will leave you breathless.

Visit one of the most beautiful in Serbia, Stopića cave, which is decoratively lit and arranged for visitors. The tour of the cave takes about 20 minutes and the walk to it takes about 20 minutes both ways.

SPECIAL NATURE RESERVE UVAC

Cruising/ Walking/ Picnic on the view point

Departure after breakfast at 9:00.

Transfer around one hour to the Special Nature Reserve Uvac, where you will embark amazing natural beauty.

You'll see the biggest attractions of the Special Nature Reserve, a griffon vulture, up close. You can observe the eagles (vultures) and other birds on nests and in flight.

During the catamaran ride along the Uvac meanders you will enjoy the unreal nature with a story about the history of the area and the griffon vultures, which are a strictly protected bird species that was on the verge of extinction. You'll hear the whole story of the Ice Cave which can be seen only from the boat.

The cave is not arranged for the tourist visits at the moment, and the entrance is not allowed.

We'll take a walk (1300 m) to viewpoint overlooking the incredible Uvac meanders. At this viewpoint, you will be delighted with the view of the Uvac meanders and a view reserved only for griffon vultures.

Outdoor picnic lunch with traditional dishes of the Zlatar mountain will be organized here at the viewpoint. You will taste the world's most delicious white Zlatar cheese while enjoying the view and nature.

Walk back to catamaran and cruise back to starting point.

*An additional option for this adventure is a combination of a cruise and a jeep ride to the viewpoint. You can take jeeps to the viewpoint, have a picnic then go down the footpath to the catamaran and go on a one-way cruise. Or vice versa.



As part of the campaign "Hugging between the North and South" carried out by the Tourist Organizations of Niš (south) and Indjija (north), we created this original program as a tribute to the introduction and fusion of different cultures and regions, the north and the south of our beautiful Serbia.

Arrival in Indjija on a tour of Celtic Village, a thematic tourist complex inspired by the life of the Celts about 2300 years ago. What connects Niš and Indjija is the life of the Celts on the territory of these two cities and their passion for good fun.

Embarking on a unique program in Serbia and Europe. Danube cruise to an attractive Krčedin river island, part of a protected nature area, where domestic animals live freely in a preserved natural environment and mutual harmony. You will enjoy a walk and a photo safari, surrounded by a herd of peaceful horses, mangalica pigs, birds, and other domestic animals. Podolian cattle live here, a rare and beautiful animal with long horns, which belongs to the endangered sustainable breeds. Preservations activities for this species were undertaken here. After enjoying the natural and wild environment, the cruise returns to the starting point and the restaurant on the banks of the Danube, where you will have lunch and refreshments with elderflower lemonade and the most beautiful strudel with poppy seeds that you have never eaten before. opportunity to try so far.

We will visit wine atelier Šapat which is located in the most beautiful place on the Danube and whose restaurant aspires for Michelin stars.

Departure to the Acuminicum winery located in a house that is a cultural monument. The remain of the Turkish hammam which is an integral part of the house is a wine-tasting area, which gives this place a special charm.

Dinner in authentic Salaš.

Note: The program can be adjusted if the group wants to enjoy a balloon flight in addition to the photo safari, which is organized on the same river island, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Saturdays, and Sundays, from 7-8:30 p.m.

DANUBE THROUGH THE HISTORY

Whole day tour/ Iron Gate/ Archaeological Sites/ Golubac Fortress

Start point Belgrade.

Check-out and departure after breakfast at 8:00 by bus.

Explore the Danube river and Roman sites. Visit the Viminacium, a major city and military camp of the Roman province of Moesia, today Serbia, and the capital of Moesia Superior. It lies on the old Roman road Via Militaris, which also passes via Sićevo gorge in the region of Niš City.

We continue our journey to Golubac fortified town, one of the best-preserved medieval towns in Serbia. Its location is at the entry of the Iron Gate gorge of the Danube. It is the largest and most beautiful gorge in Europe, dating to the 14th century.

Lunch at the beautiful and unique spot of the ethno-complex on the hill above the Danube. During lunch, you can enjoy the spectacular view of the Danube.

At the end of this cultural and historical tour, we will visit Lepenski Vir (Lepenski Whirl) a Mesolithic archaeological site the oldest urban settlement in Europe (dating from 9500/7200 to 6000 BC).

We continue a short drive to the hotel in Kladovo.

Free time, dinner and overnight.

Note: We can exclude Viminacium and include 2 hours of Danube cruise in the afternoon, or visit of Fetislam Fortress.

DANUBE CRUISE & FELIX ROMULIANA

Whole day tour/ Danube Cruise/ Felix Romuliana - UNESCO site/ Niš

Check-out and departure after breakfast at 9:00 by bus.

Short ride to Tekija port where we will start our 2 hours long cruising in the **Iron Gate** (Djerdap gorge) on the route Tekija - Kazani - Tekija. You will have the opportunity to enjoy the most beautiful part of the Iron Gate and the Danube. It passes by the place where the Roman emperor Trajan left his indelible mark on the rock, better known as Trajan's plaque. Then the ship passes through Mali Kazan (small river passage) place where the Danube is the deepest in its entire course, next to the statue of the last Dacian king Decebalus Rex carved into the rock and Orthodox monastery Mrakonia. You'll see signal stations on the Danube and the place where the Danube is the narrowest in its entire course.

After cruise we will continue our route to the villages **Rajac** and Rogljevo, a complex of 270 wine cellars from the 18th century. These authentic wine cellars are recognizable by their appearance of stone houses, which have become very famous in the country and abroad. Lunch break in one of the cellar.

Felix Romuliana which is archaeological site on the UNESCO World Heritage List. This palace represents an artistic achievement of late antiquity 3rd and 4th centuries. It's the work of Roman Emperor Galerius Velerius Maximinus, who became the heir to the emperor Diocletian after marrying his daughter Valeria. But, the love for his mother Romula that had no bounds had proved when he built a magnificent palace Felix Romuliana in Gamzigrad, near today's Zaječar City.

After Romuliana we continue our travel to south Serbia and Niš, the birth place of the famous Roman Emperor Constantine the Great.

Check-in at hotel, dinner and overnight.

Inclusions:

Travel guide, tickets for cruising, and Felix Romuliana.

NIŠ THROUGH THE CENTURIES

Half day tour/ Culture/ History / 4 to 6 hours

The city walks via Obrenovićeva Street to the King's Milan Square (the city center) and the monument to the liberators of Niš city. You'll also hear the story about Banovina, the former building of the old Niš administration and the Cabinet of the Prime Minister of Serbia, in which he received a telegram, on July 28, 1914, by which Austria-Hungary declared war on Serbia, formally marking the beginning of the First World War.

A tour of the Niš Fortress, a symbol of the city and one of the best-preserved fortresses in the Balkans, with preserved buildings from the Ottoman Empire and archeological excavations from the period of the Roman Empire. Located in the very center of the city on the right bank of the Nišava River, its final shape, after numerous demolitions and renovations, was given in 1723 when the Turks restored it. Even today, the Niš Fortress lives as an inseparable tissue of the city center and the capital of festivals, knightly games, tourists, and good times.

Transfer to Skull Tower, the unique monument in the world of great importance testifies to the tragic history of the Serbs after the battle of Čegar.

Short drive to the archaeological site **Mediana**, a Roman settlement created at the end of the 3rd or early 4th century, consisting of a complex of summer residences such as urban villas and a large farm by the road that led to Serdica and Constantinople. Mediana is declared an immovable cultural asset of exceptional importance. Among the researched buildings, the following stand out: a villa with a peristyle, baths, a wine cellar, a palace with an octagonal tower, two early Christian churches, and a necropolis.

After visiting Medina wine lovers will be able to experience a unique journey through wine time, from Roman times to the present day, in the over 110-year-old wine cellar. What makes the Malča cellar recognizable and unique in Serbia is the wine that is aged in amphorae, just like in Roman times. Lunch or dinner at the winery restaurant.

The duration of the tour is around 4 hours, with lunch/dinner being 6 hours.

MONASTERY MANASIJA & RESAVA CAVE

Culture/ Monastery/ Cave/ Waterfall

Departure by organized transport at 08:30.

For an incredibly long time, nature here created the Beljanica mountain and its undulating slopes, the Resava river and its steep canyons, the Resava cave and dozens of others, hot springs and waterfalls, vast forests, and meadows.

Even from the access road, above the Resava river, the walls of the monastery complex, built by the despot Stefan Lazarevic, can be seen. The fortress consists of 12 m high walls reinforced with 11 towers, the most famous of which is the donjon - so-called Despot's Tower. **The monastery Manasija** is dedicated to the Holy Trinity. It is one of the most significant monuments of medieval Serbian culture and it belongs to the "Morava school".

Resava cave is the most famous and most visited cave in Serbia. It has the status of a protected natural monument. Because of the richness and variety of jewelry, the Resava Cave is also called "Resava Beauty". The total length of the canal is currently 4.5 km, while an 800-meter-long path has been arranged for visitors. The lowest point visitors can reach is 405 m above sea level. Cave jewelry is already present at the very entrance, three colors predominate yellow (clay), white (calcium crystal), and red (iron oxide). The temperature in the Resava cave is constant throughout the year +7°C. Be prepared and bring appropriate clothing and footwear for visiting the cave at this temperature. Visit to the cave is optional.

Museum in Despotovac - Miniature Park is a unique tourist offer in Serbia. The models of 20 of the most significant monuments of medieval Serbian culture were made on a scale of 1:17 compared to the monasteries in real size.

Lunch break in a traditional tavern.

The Lisine waterfall is over 20 meters high and is considered one of the highest waterfalls in Serbia. It is most beautiful in the spring because then you can see it with the most amount of water, but its magic can also be enjoyed during the summer heat. It is protected as a natural monument.

Note: good to visit on the way from Niš to Belgrade or VS.

KRUŠEVAC THE CITY OF PRINC LAZAR

Culture/Heritage/Nature

Departure after breakfast at 9:00.

Drive from Niš to Kruševac and further to Vrnjačka Spa and Kraljevo.

Featuring a very favorable geographical position, Kruševac area inhabited the population even in prehistoric times. Archaeological findings speak of life in this area since the Neolithic. However, the search for the origin of Kruševac leads us to the middle Ages, in the time of Prince Lazar, who introduced it to history as its capital in the eighth decade of the XIV century.

The Battle of Kosovo took place on June 15, 1389, between an army lead by the Serbian Prince Lazar Hrebeljanovic and invading Ottoman Empire, led by Sultan Murad I. During the battle, Prince Lazar was captured and killed, as well as many prominent Serbian warriors. The most important holiday for Kruševac is certainly "Vidovdan", deeply rooted in the consciousness of the population in this region as the day of Prince Lazar's death and his struggle to protect his state and people. In Serbian tradition, anniversaries of the battle have celebrated on 28th June, according to Gregorian calendar which corresponds to 15th Jun (the Julian calendar).

Visit the archaeological Park "Lazar's Town" and the church Lazarica which has rightly called the pearl of Moravian architecture. It has built-in 1375 or 1376 in honor of Prince Lazar's firstborn son Despot Stefan, heir of the throne, the patron of the Nemanjić Dynasty.

We continue to Vrnjačka Spa the queen of Serbian spa towns. Lunch at local restaurant.

Vrnjačka Spa has a very long healing tradition. The Romans built their spa at the Vrnjačka hot mineral spring between the 2nd and 4th centuries. Vrnjačke Banje is the richest and most interesting tourist area in Serbia, especially attractive and full of events during the summer.

Overnight in Vrnjačka Spa or Kraljevo.

STUDENICA & ŽIČA MONASTERIES

Culture/Heritage/Nature

Departure after breakfast at 9:00.

Drive from Kraljevo or Vrnjačka Spa to the monastery Žiča in the vicinity of Kraljevo.

This monastery is from the 13th century and here was crowned seven Serbian kings.

In 1219, Žiča became the first seat of the Serbian archdiocese. The church, which is dedicated to the resurrection of Jesus, has a characteristic depiction from the "Raška school".

The journey continues through beautiful nature and the valley of the river Ibar to another jewel of medieval architecture Studenica monastery. You will enjoy unusual scenes passing this gorge, beautiful nature and traces left by people over time, like the fortified town of Maglič, which oversees the river and guards the way through the gorge.

Arriving at the most prominent Serbian monastery which was founded in the 12th century by Stefan Nemanja, the founder of the medieval state of Serbia. Tour of the monastery complex. Whether you are a believer or not, this site will not leave you indifferent. The tour of the complex starts from the Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The most beautiful frescoes from the 12th century are hidden here, including the famous crucifixion of Christ, which is considered the most important fresco of the monastery. You will also have the opportunity to explore the rest of the complex and localities such as the King's church, the treasury and the church of St. Nicholas.

Lunch break at local tavern next to monastery complex.

Drive back to hotel for overnight in Kraljevo.

Note: After Studenica monastery the group can continue to Zlatibor mountain for overnight. This program can make connection and vise versa.

SERBIAN ROYAL FAMILY MAUSOLEUM

Oplenac Topola/ Culture/ King's winery

Departure after breakfast at 09:30 by bus.

Transport to Topola. A half-hour walk to the top of Oplenac, at an altitude of 347 meters, rises the Temple of St. George and the Mausoleum of the Serbian Royal Family Karadjordjevic. One of the strongest characteristics of the temple as a building is its interior decoration, made of a mosaic that covers an area of 3,570 m2. Five rulers of the Karadjordjevic dynasty and 24 members of the closest family found their eternal peace in the silence of the Oplenac temple. We will also visit Karadjordje Town, and the winegrower's house – the royal winery.

The King's diary notes are a very important and valuable document in which you can find out about everyday life in Topola. The king lived in the house, with short interruptions, until the fall of 1915, when he and his army began to withdraw from their homeland via Albania to Thessaloniki. In this house, Regent Aleksandar, between 1914 and 1915, coming from the main headquarters located in Kragujevac, submitted reports and plans for military operations. King Peter himself said that he loved to stay in this house and that in front of it, there is a wonderful view of his homeland and his endowment. Today, Peter's House is a museum gallery with thematic exhibits related to the Karadjordjevic dynasty.

As the Topola region has always been known for its vineyards, a house for winegrowers was built in Oplenac near the endowment complex. It is built in the traditional Šumadija style and is located on the northern slope of Oplenac. Its basements are buried in a slight slope of the land, and it has a spacious porch. It was built in 1911 and the manager of the royal vineyards lived in it for some time. Today, its premises serve as a gallery space, among the exhibits of which is the legacy of the famous Serbian painter Nikola Graovac.
